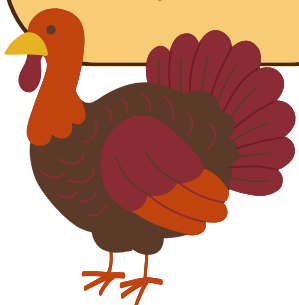
This time of year always reminds us of how lucky we are to be surrounded by such caring families and remarkable little learners.
